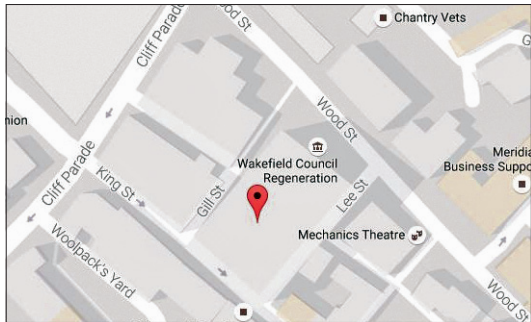
Public rally hosted by Stand Up To Racism All welcome
